Dear Mrs. Zvolenská

Peter Visolajský, Chairman of the Medical Trade Unions Association (LOZ), sent me copy of a letter he sent to you concerning persecutory activities against him.

On behalf of FEMS I criticized the project of law concerning the punishment of doctors protesting for their working conditions and I thank you for answering me. It was a problem of policy of your Governmente and Parliament and FEMS exposed the reasons why we couldn't accept such a political decision.

But this is a different matter: a trade union representative, nowhere in a democratic Country can be object of persecutory activity by chiefs and administrators of the institution where he works, due to his activity, even in the mildest form, e.g. applying common rules in a hyper-restrictive manner.

LOZ is a very respected member of our European Federation, therefore I ask you, please, to intervene, as the highest Slovak Authority in the Health National System, to stop the persecutory activity against, in this particular case, Peter Visolajský, but, on a general base, against the Trade Union representatives who just make the activity, they were chosen for, by the workers.
