On 28 July 2013 I sent a letter to Viviane Reding, Commissioner for Justice, Fundamental Rights and Citizenship of the EU Commission at that time, to bring to her attention the unacceptable situation of Slovak Healthcare Workers, due to a law, approved by the Slovak Parliament on April 23rd 2013, aimed to criminalize their protest for better working conditions.

FEMS supported the Slovak doctors and, finally, asked for the intervention of Commissioner Reding, but we did not receive any reply.

The situation in Slovakia has not changed and we renew the request for the intervention of the Commissioner for Justice.
