### **Report of Cyprus Turkish Medical Association.**

Not a major change apart from the minister of health happened in the north part of Cyprus.

There is a growing concern of newly qualified doctors not wanting to work in the government hospitals due to gross reduction of the doctors' salaries for the new starters. Some are starting to work but soon they resign.

Laws about reorganizing the system are not completed yet and same concerns and accusations of doctors working in the government working outside as well is continuing.

Private sector is not happy either because they are not still capable of running effective emergency services and intensive care units. Patient directly have to pay out of their pocket which is almost impossible for the public.

New medical faculty construction is under way despite growing concern about the level of education of these doctors.

Medical association is continuously warning the ministry of health about the existing concerns.

New oncology hospital is finished, but not opened!!
