NATIONAL REPORT PORTUGAL May 2017

Since current government took office, several meetings took place between both Unions and Health Ministry as an attempt to address some of medical doctor's claims.

However, due to constant delays by government representatives when its time to close a subject, outcomes are very limited and disappointing.

Despite having been already accepted by the ministry, some crucial issues such as those related to compensatory rest after a night shift, opening of competition or training of young doctors are yet to be realized

Other issues as the full payment of extraordinary work, the reduction in the number of working hours in the Emergency Room, a career review and of its salary scale, or an effective reduction in the number of patients per family doctor ratio, are all subjects which the ministry is apparently showing no interest in realizing during this current year.

For all these reasons, medical doctor's Unions have enacted a strike for the 10th and 11th of May.

Both Unions (FNAM and SIM) remain united in these negotiations and in the decision to enact the strike.
