Country report

Romania

May 2022

The period since the last general meeting of the EMFF was not rich in notable events.

- 1.** In February in Romania there was a change in the structure of the government and a related change in the Minister of Health. The new minister is a specialist in microbiology and epidemiology, he is also the doctor who represented our country in the WHO.
- 2.** In March, the alert was suspended and many restrictive measures related to pandemics were lifted.
- 3.** In April, the number of cases reported by covid was around 2,000 a day, with about 15 deaths.
- 4.** The total number of citizens who want to get vaccinated in our country remains very small. Lifting the restrictions has further reduced the number of people who want to be vaccinated. The new health minister said a large number of vaccines had expired and could not be used.
- 5.** 2,000 employees were permanently employed, which were used only for the pandemic period.
