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The Head of the Executive noted that additional funds were allocated to Health, considering that this field is a priority for the Government.

The Prime Minister declared that during the budget rectification, additional funds aimed at all the projects to modernize and support the medical services, corroborated of course with the projects that are ongoing through European funds and which are also to be accessed and implemented through the National Plan of Recovery and Resilience. The necessary sums have been allocated, so that the payment of medical leaves is ensured.

The Minister of Health wants the SMURD emergency service, the Ambulance and the emergency reception units to be subordinated to the Ministry of Internal Affairs from the Ministry of Health, more precisely to the Department for Emergency Situations. Now the Ministry of Health finances the activity of these emergency services.

The Minister of Health announced that in the coming period, anti-COVID vaccination centers will be opened in health facilities, as a preparation measure for the autumn immunization campaign, when a serum adapted to the new variants of the Omicron strain is expected.

Now the anti-COVID vaccination is done in the offices of family doctors. He encouraged family doctors to participate in the anti-Covid vaccination, recalling the increase in the proportion of acceptable losses to 50%.

Testing can be done at family doctors, hospitals, medical clinics, pharmacies. It is not an emergency to open the new testing centers because the ambulance services are coping.

The number of serious cases of SARS Cov-2 in children, adolescents and young people has increased.
